

Inglemoor Junior Football – Emergency Plan

Please review this policy and follow it in the event of an emergency.

Be Prepared –

- Make sure all gates that provide access to the location of the incident are open; these include but are not limited to
 - Exterior gates at both ends (N & S) of the High school (HS)
 - The Emergency gate for the South end of Turf Field
 - When appropriate the entrance to the Baseball – Soccer – Softball complex at the North end of the HS
- Several people have Keys to the complex. The school employee assigned to monitor our field use, the Club President (Billie Hartline (206-898-9021), Executive VP Mike Brejda , Equipment VP Mel Mersberg, and Field Manager VP Paul Loken also has access to keys. In the event none of these individuals are present call Billie Hartline and he will instruct you on how to access a set of keys.

Make sure there is a cell phone present at all games and practices

Make sure that phone numbers for all parents are available at all practices and games. This information is contained in the Coaches Book. A master copy will be available at the Equipment Shed

Roles of First Responders

- Immediate care of the injured
 - calm and reassure the victim
 - have one person stay with victim if possible

Activation of the emergency medical system (EMS)

- Call 911
 - provide name
 - location
 - telephone number
 - number of individuals injured
 - condition of injured
 - first aid treatment provided
 - specific directions - tell them that where the injured is located ie: on the Turf field immediately behind the High school or on the Soccer field immediately North of the HS, etc.
 - other info as requested
 - BE THE LAST TO HANG UP
 - Scene Control: limit scene to first aid providers.

Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to the scene

- Meet in Parking lot

If the parent is not present designate a person to call them and notify them as soon as possible
